From the context of verses 10-17, what do you think was the main reason for division?

Do you think we still struggle with these types of divisions? Why or why not?

Paul describes the message of the cross as foolishness, a stumbling block, and a mystery. Why does he use these words to describe it this way?

What part does the Spirit play in our understanding of the ways of God/having the mind of Christ?

What significance does the Spirit of God have in your life?
